What is this exhibition about?

This exhibition is about the internet.
Many people use the internet.
The internet changes our lives.
It changes how we talk to each other.

What happens to us on the internet?

On the internet, we share
pictures and information about ourselves.
The information you share is called a profile.
On your profile, you can choose

You can use computer programs
to make your pictures look nicer.
One example of programs is a filter.
A filter makes your pictures look nicer.
The internet connects the whole world.
But the internet can also make us feel sad.
We can feel lonely.
We can feel like we are missing out on good things.

How does the internet work?

On the internet, computer programs guide our attention.

The programs decide what we see on our screens.

The internet has two parts:

There is a part you can see.

There is a part you cannot see.

The internet needs a lot of cables and computers.

The internet uses a lot of electricity.

Today, we have artificial intelligence.

Artificial intelligence means that computers can think by themselves.

Computers can make fake pictures.

It is hard to know what is real and what is fake.

How can you visit the exhibition?

The exhibition is built like the internet.

You can look at anything you want on the internet.

You can walk anywhere you want in this exhibition.

There are no rules about where you must go.

There are no closed rooms.

You decide which artwork you want to see first.

The exhibition does not give final answers to your questions.

The exhibition helps you to slow down.

It helps you think about how you use your phone and your computer.
